Sri Aurobindo Society is an international non-governmental organisation, founded in 1960 by the Mother “to make known to the members and people in general the aims and ideals of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother, their system of Integral Yoga, and to work for its fulfilment in all possible ways and for the attainment of a spiritual society as envisaged by Sri Aurobindo.”

The Society strives for a new world order based on spirituality, and has the following specific objectives:

- The integral growth and perfection of the individual.
- Social transformation and the establishment of an environment favourable to the flowering and growth of the individual according to his/her innermost needs and truth of being.
- A united and resurgent India.
- The realisation of human unity in a harmonious and organised diversity, where each nation will become conscious of its true genius and offer its best for the whole of mankind.

The Society holds information and consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council and has also been recognised by the Government of India as a Research Organisation in Social Sciences.
